





NOUVEL BUILDING

Designed by architect Jean Nouvel, the construction adapts to the southwest facade of the Sabatini Building and to the triangular plot of land before it. Nouvel respected the lay out of the site by adding three new units to the pre-existing complex.

The opening of the new building redefined visitors' itineraries throughout the Museum. Providing an alternative entrance as well as several connections between Sabatini Galleries and Nouvel new spaces this innovative distribution generates a number of possible routes while creating a clear distinction of service areas and exhibition space.





SABATINI BUILDING

Founded as San Carlos Hospital in the XVIII century, the building is named after Francisco Sabatini, the architect responsible for its construction.

The interior is opened to a patio, which is surrounded by large vaulted galleries hold by stone pilasters and some of the exhibition rooms. With windows overlooking the patio as well as the exterior the building allows natural lighting in.

There are also alternative spaces within the edifice such as the vaulted brick made cellars or the Protocol Room, the hospital old linen room featuring still the original furniture and now adapted for exhibition purposes.
